Your Ohio Resident Educator Summative Assessment (RESA) score report below contains your overall results from the **2013-2014 RESA**, including “Passed” and “Not Passed” determinations for each task. Your RESA results have been submitted to the Ohio Department of Education.

How to read this report:

Resident Educators must pass all RESA tasks in order to pass the RESA. The first table, Score Overview, shows how many RESA tasks you passed and your 2013-2014 RESA status—Passed or Not Passed. If you receive a “Not Passed” determination for any task, you are eligible to resubmit that task. More information on the retake process is included on the [Resources page](#) of the OhioRESA.com website. The task submission deadline for candidates retaking one or more tasks is **May 15, 2015**.

The Scoring Breakdown table provides more information on how you performed against the passing standard set for each task. For Tasks 1–4, the overall task score is a summation of all rubric component scores. This sum, or total “raw” score, has been converted to a scaled score. The scaled score range for the Ohio RESA is 100–300. The passing score for Tasks 1–4 is 200. The lowest possible score is 100, and the highest possible score is 300. Please note that Task 5, Reflection on Teaching Practice Based on Feedback from Students and/or Colleagues, does not have a numerical score. This task was scored on a “completion standard.” Every candidate who successfully completed Task 5 in accordance with the task instructions will receive a passing score.

A Brief Summary of the Standard Setting Process:

The Standard Setting Committee for the Ohio RESA determined these cut scores. This committee includes educators representing diverse teaching environments across the state of Ohio. The Standard Setting Committee recommended a passing standard for each rubric associated with RESA Tasks 1–4. The sum of all rubric component passing scores determined the committee’s recommendation for an overall passing standard for that task. When necessary, the committee adjusted its recommendations, after reviewing the results for the 2013–2014 RESA candidates. The Standard Setting Committee then recommended the RESA passing standards to the Educator Standards Board of the State of Ohio, and this board recommended the passing standards for final consideration by the State Board of Education of Ohio. The State Board of Education of Ohio voted to adopt the passing standards on December 9, 2014.
